MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND MUSIC JOB DESCRIPTION

Principal Function: To model, serve, and lead the body of Christ in worship, discipleship, and outreach through the music and religious educational ministries of the church.

- 1. The minister of Education and Music is responsible to the Pastor.
- 2. Provide leadership and vision for the music and education ministries.
- 3. Work with the pastor and other worship leadership in developing and implementing meaningful worship experiences for the congregation.
- 4. Lead the congregation in corporate worship through the best use of musical gifts and talents of the church.
- 5. Assist the Pastor in planning congregational services; be responsible for selection of the music. Preview the music planned to be sung or played by individuals or groups.
- 6. Assist in outreach visitation, hospital visitation, and other pastoral duties as needed
- 7. Lead in planning and calendaring events and activities related to the educational ministry.
- 8. Develop and facilitate the budget of the educational and music ministry.
- 9. Lead the church family to understand and support the educational ministries of the church.
- 10. Responsible for enlisting and training leaders for the church educational and music program in cooperation with the appropriate persons and/or the church nominating committee.
- 11. Coordinate the production of church publications.
- 12. Provide planning and direction to church wide visitation.
- 13. Provide administrative assistance to Student and Childrengs ministries.
- 14. Provide assistance and counsel when needed or requested for special events such as weddings, funerals, and banquets.
- 15. Serve as staff liaison to church committees as designated by Pastor
- 16. Cooperate with associational, state convention, and Southern Baptist Convention leaders in promoting mutual interest activities of the denomination and the church.
