MINISTER OF EDUCATION

Principle Function: Responsible for assisting the educational organizations of the church in planning, conducting, and evaluating a comprehensive program of Christian education and training.

<u>Qualifications for the Position</u>: Possess significant knowledge of the Christian education and training system and process. A degree in Christian religious education from an accredited seminary or equivalent experience is considered optimum.

Requirements of Position:

- 1. Lead the church in planning, conducting, and evaluating a comprehensive program of Christian education and training.
- 2. Serve as educational resource person and advisor to the leaders of assigned program, service, and committee organizations.
- 3. Develop special education and training projects such as retreats, study sessions and seminars for various age groups and program organizations.
- 4. Lead the church to be aware of the latest trends in Christian Education; lead in choosing suitable curriculum.
- 5. Guide in the designation, enlistment, and training of lay workers.
- 6. Maintain an adequate system of records.
- 7. Develop and administer a program of church-wide out-reach visitation.
- 8. Promote and direct the weekly officers' and teachers' meetings.
- 9. Coordinate the submission of the annual budget for all assigned programs and organizations.
- 10. Serve as staff advisor for the educational facet of special and pastoral ministry areas such as home-bound and nursing home Bible teaching programs.
- 11. Be available to the Pastor and Associate Pastor to assist them in the accomplishment of their ministries; perform additional duties as assigned by the Senior Minister.
- 12. Coordinate and provide administrative leadership to assigned committees, and program and ministry organizations.
