Interim Pastor Responsibilities

Here is a list of possible activities for an interim pastor. You should discuss this list with him and come to an agreement regarding which ones he will perform. Remember that most interim pastors have a limited amount of time. His compensation should reflect what you are asking him to do. If you are asking to do 50% of what your former full-time pastor did, then you should compensate him at 50% of the former pastor's salary. (In many cases, interim pastors have benefits provided through other means and, thus, would not factor into the compensation package.)

Leading mid-week services, either Bible study or prayer meeting
Sermon preparation
Conducting funerals & bereavement ministry
Supervising staff
Conducting weddings
Performing baptisms of new converts
Visiting the hospitals (how often?)
Visiting the shut-ins (how often?)
Visiting new members
Visiting prospects
Crisis counseling
Leadership training
General counseling
Social events
Extra programs (e.g. music, WMU)
Deacon meetings
Committee meetings
